ASAP: The Additional Skill Acquisition Programme

The Department is Co-ordinating the ASAP programme of the Govt. of Kerala, in the college. Two camps of 21 days each, with 60 participants from all over the state, were organised during the Summer vacation (13-5-2013 -2-6-2013). The college was granted A Star status by the Higher Education Dept. for this programme.
